RURAL MUNICIPALITY of ST. CLEMENTS

BY-LAW NO. 3-2018

Being a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of St. Clements to establish a rate for curbside waste and recycling pickup as a special service to occupied residential properties located in the mapped area including Lockport, Narol, Gonor, East Selkirk, Ashfield, West Pine Ridge, West Garson and NE 59/44 for the years 2018-2023 inclusive; excluding properties that have opted out and vacant lots

WHEREAS Section 312 of The Municipal Act (hereinafter known as the "Act") of Manitoba, provides in part as follows:

- If approved by by-law, a municipality may provide, as a special service to all or part of the municipality, The following:
 - (e) the collection and transportation of waste or recyclable materials;

AND WHEREAS subsection 320(1) of the Act provides as follows:

- 320(1) Subject to subsections (2) to (6) and subsection 321(4), a council may by By-law
 - (a) approve the local improvement or special service as set out in the plan or proposal; and
 - (b) authorize the municipality to impose taxes as set out in the plan or proposal.

AND WHEREAS the Council of R.M. of St. Clements has prepared Special Service Plan No. 2017-02 to establish per parcel rate for curbside waste and recycling pickup within the areas of Lockport, Narol, Gonor, East Selkirk, Ashfield, West Pine Ridge, West Garson and NE 59/44 as a special service pursuant to Part 10 of the Act;

AND WHEREAS the requirements as prescribed in section 318, 319, and 320 of the Act have been complied with;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of R.M. of St. Clements in open council assembled enacts as follows:

- 1. That pursuant to Section 320(1) of the Act, the R.M. of St. Clements approves Special Service Proposal No. 2017-02 attached hereby as Schedule "A".
- 2. The R.M. of St. Clements levies an annual special service tax upon properties within Lockport, Narol, Gonor, East Selkirk, Ashfield, West Pine Ridge, West Garson and NE 59/44 as hereby attached in Schedule "B".
