CURBSIDE Garbage & Recycling Pickup Collection Zones

Collection Zone 1 - Monday

West side of PTH 59 from Coronation Rd north up to and including Ludwick Rd and east of PTH 59 from Coronation Road north to 3 Mile Rd

Collection Zone 2 - Tuesday

West side of PTH 59 north of Ludwick Rd up to and including PTH 44

Collection Zone 3 - Tuesday


West side of PTH 59 from north of HWY 44 north up to and including PR 509 (CIL Rd)

Collection Zone 4 - Wednesday

West side of PTH 59 north of PR 509 (CIL Rd) and up to PR 508 (paved), continuing north between the Red River and St. Peters Rd to just north of Peltz Drive

Collection Zone 5 - Wednesday

East of PTH 59, from Boundary Rd north to Road 76 including the Goodman's subdivision

Acceptable Items



SINGLE STREAM, NO-SORT RECYCLING IS EFFICIENT, IT SAVES TIME AND SPACE AND IT IS GOOD FOR THE ENVIRONMENT!

RECYCLE RIGHT, RM OF ST. CLEMENTS

Include these items (rinsed and free of grease, food and other residue) in your single stream recycle bin – no sorting or bagging required.

PLASTICS

WHAT Plastics labeled #1–7 including bottles, lids, containers, take-out food containers, clamshells and trays, #5 and #6 single serve coffee pods.

HOW Rinsed and free of grease, food and other residue.



GLASS

WHAT Glass bottles and jars.

HOW Rinsed and free of grease, food and other residue.



POLYCOAT

WHAT Boxed containers for beverages and soups.

HOW Rinsed and free of grease, food and other residue.



METAL

WHAT Tin food cans, lids and beverage containers, aluminum cans and foil.

HOW Rinsed and free of grease, food and other residue.



PAPER

WHAT Newspaper, magazines, printed paper and shredded paper.

HOW Shredded paper in a clear plastic bag. This is the only item that should be bagged.



CARDBOARD

WHAT Corrugated cardboard, box board, paper board and cartons.

HOW No larger than 4' x 4' x 1'.

How to place your recycling cart for collection

Place your cart

- back wheels towards curb or at the edge of the road; close lid

Point your cart

- cart lid opens towards the centre of the road

Space your cart

- leave one arm's length clearance (one meter or 39 inches) on all sides of each cart to allow the collection truck enough room

Look up - avoid placing your cart under hydro or telephone wires & trees



Unacceptable Items

These items require alternative handling

These items are NOT accepted with your recycling.



Napkins, paper towels and food soiled cardboard - compost these



Textiles and other items that can be re-used



Plastic items not labeled #1-7 or large plastic products



Ceramics, glassware and housewares



Hazardous waste, sharps and electronics



Diapers and personal hygiene products



Scrap metal, wires & cables, home & construction waste



Organic, kitchen, yard and animal waste

Curbside Pickup Winter TIPS

Edge of road - - - -
Edge of snow plow path - - - -

- ✓ Place cart 3 feet or more off road & out of snow plow path
- ✓ Clean snow/ice off lid
- ✓ Front of cart should face road
- ✓ Clear snow from under & 3 feet around your cart
- ✓ Before 7:00 am on the day following collection, cart should be moved off the roadside onto the homeowner's property

The homeowner is responsible for loss or damage to the cart
