

- Advance Voting All municipalities must hold at least one advance poll prior to Election Day. The Senior Election Official (SEO) will provide public notice of the date and location of the advance poll.
- Sealed Envelope Voting –
 Voters may vote in person at the municipal office or by mail. Voters need to apply to the SEO in person or in writing by October 21, 2018. (July 24, 2018 for resort communities of Winnipeg Beach, Dunnottar and Victoria Beach).
- Mobile Voting –Municipalities may establish a mobile voting station, which travels from place to place, to serve patients or residents in a health care facility. A mobile voting station may also be set up on Election Day, or before Election Day, as an advance voting opportunity
