Taxes and Grants

• Our municipal taxes have increased by 18% over the last four years while family income has not.

We must do better!

• As we move forward on major projects within the RM the majority of costs are being carried by property taxes. We have gone from getting millions of dollars of grants over the years to getting very little. \$250,000.00 in grants to build a \$5,000,000.00 plus community center is unsustainable for the residence.

We must do better!

• Next year we will be seeing a Federal election followed by a Provincial election where grants will become available; we have missed this window by already starting our projects.

Garbage and Recycle Pickup
