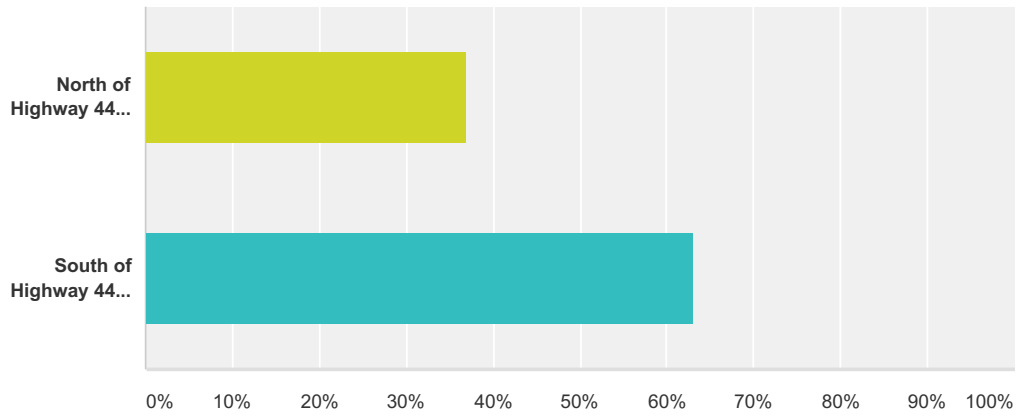

Q1 In what area of the municipality do you live?

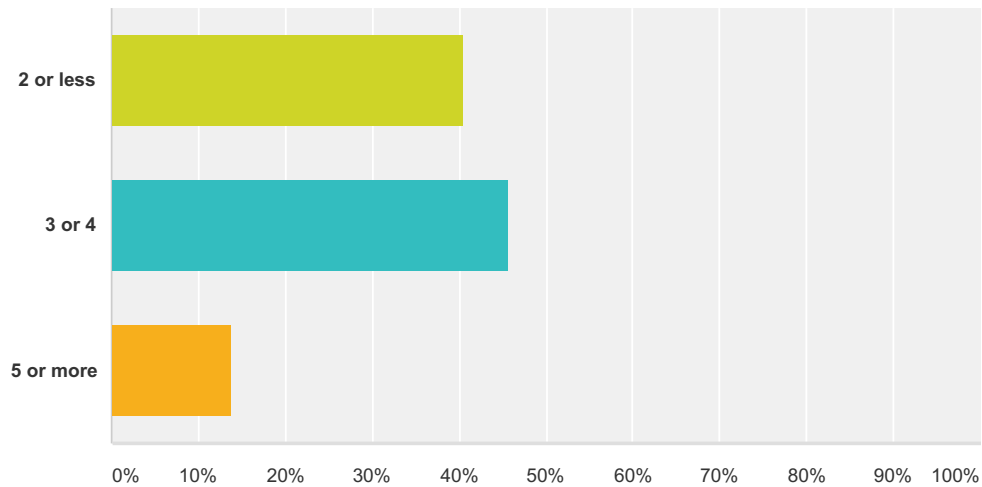

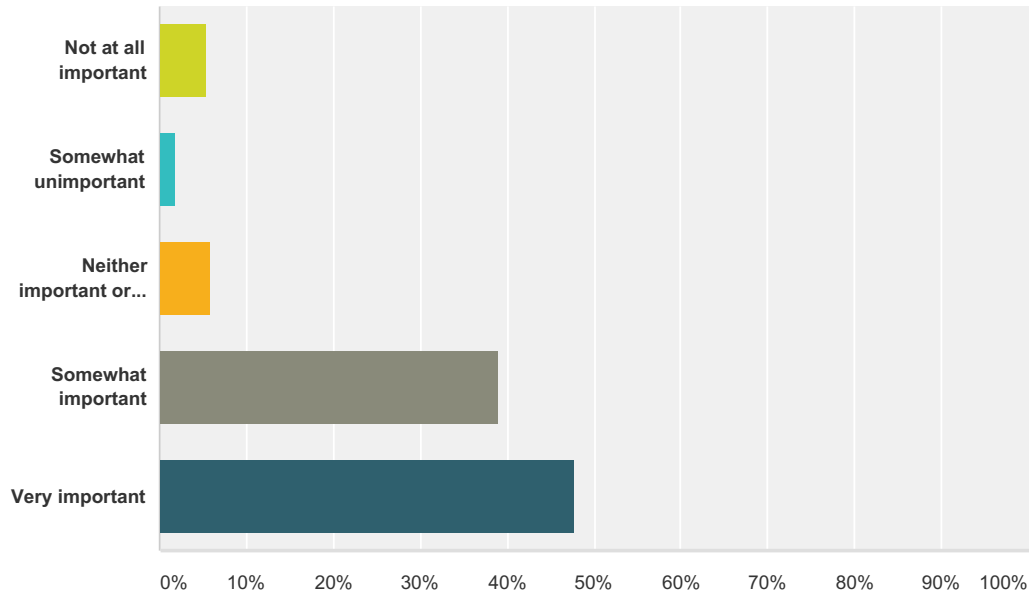

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Q3 How important are recreation facilities and services to you?

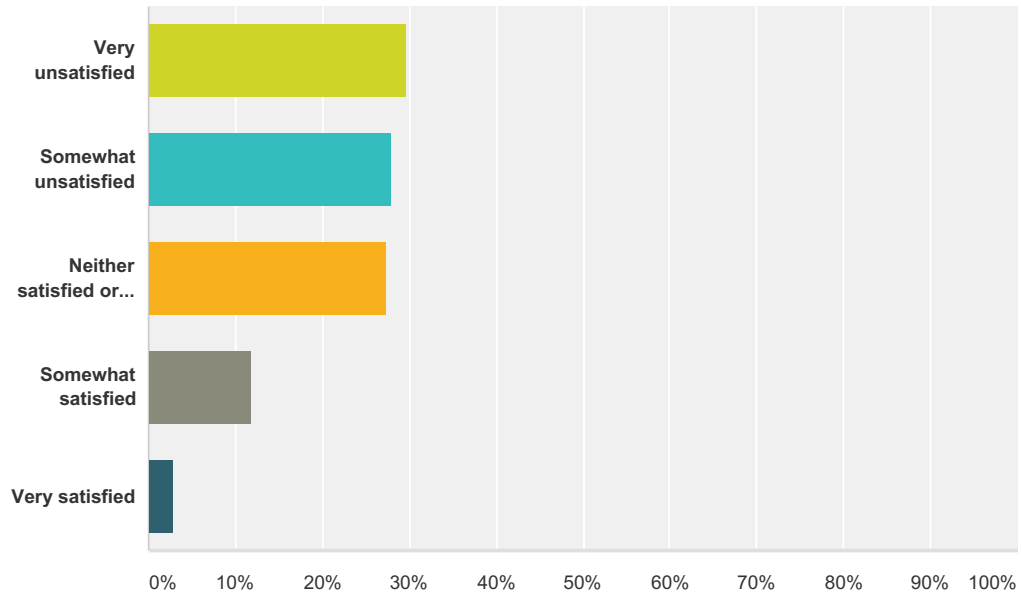

Q4 How satisfied are you with the current recreation facilities and services?

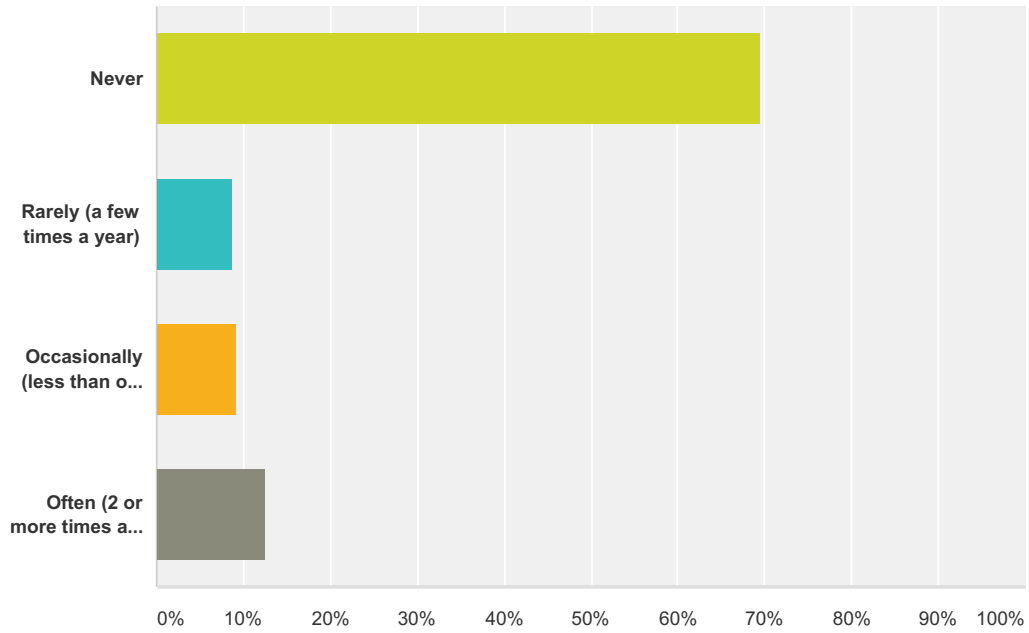

Q5 Did you ever use the Narol/Gonor Community Centre or the old Donald School property for recreation services in the past?

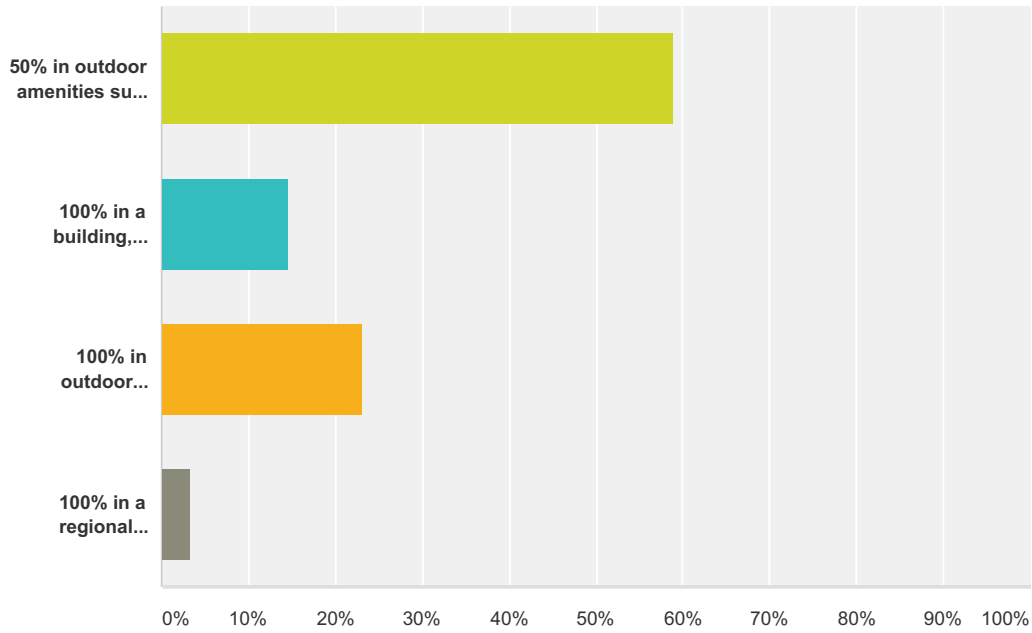

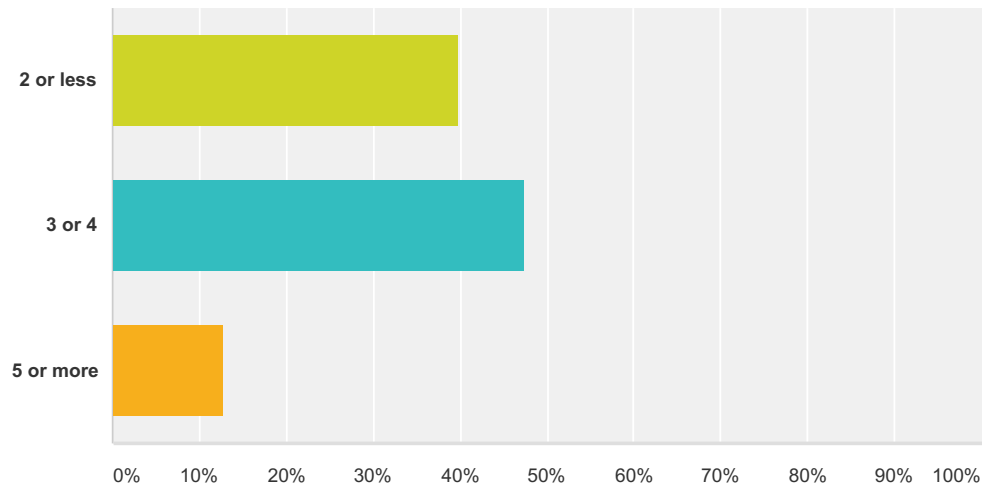

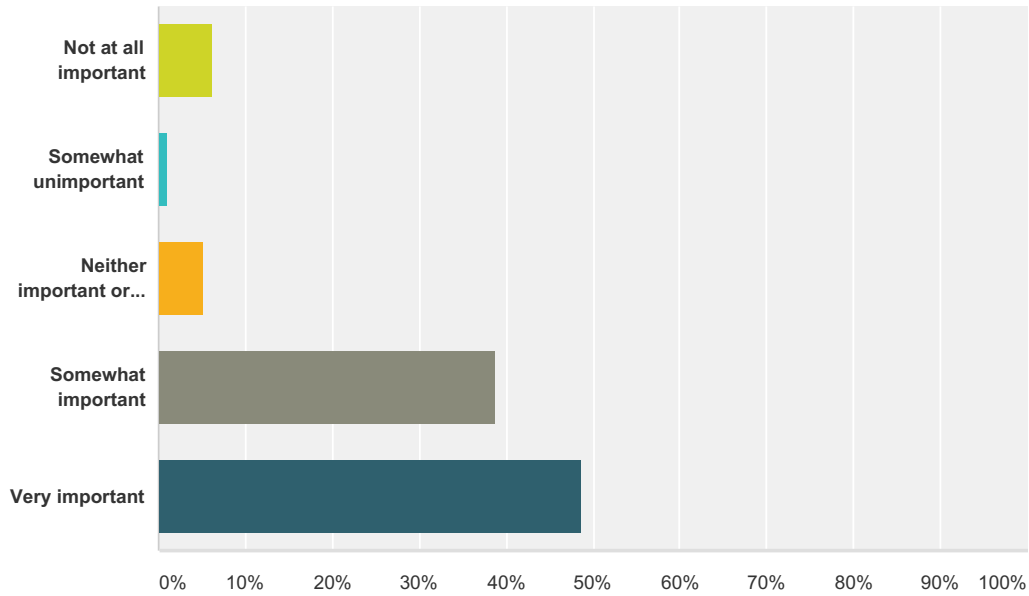

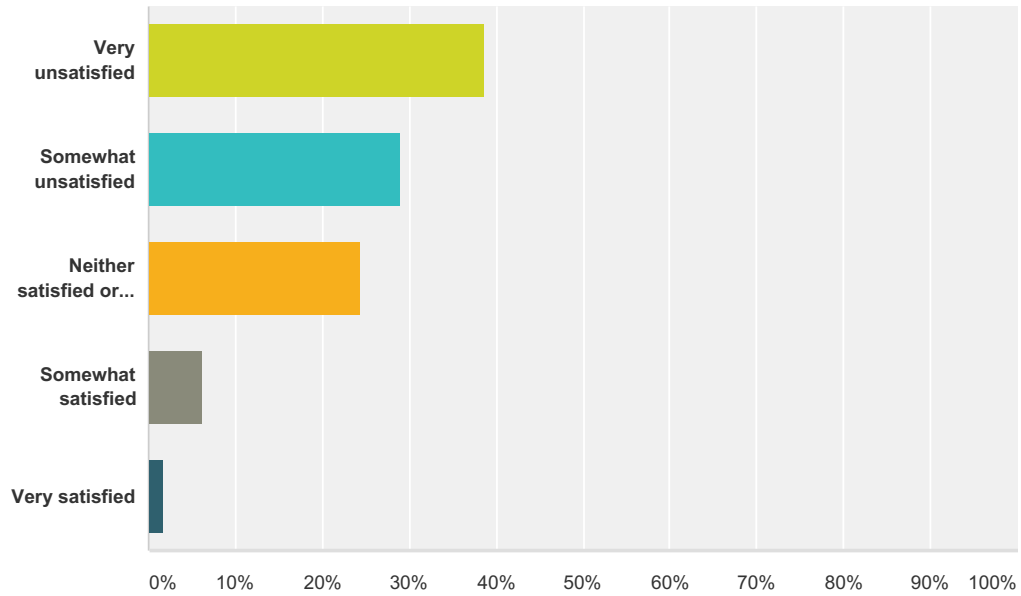

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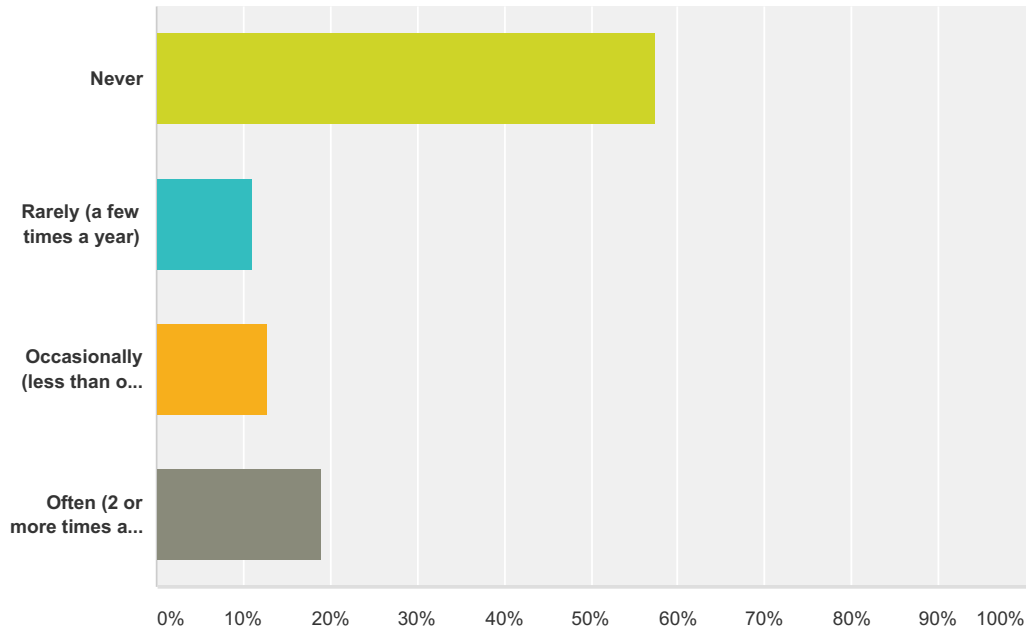

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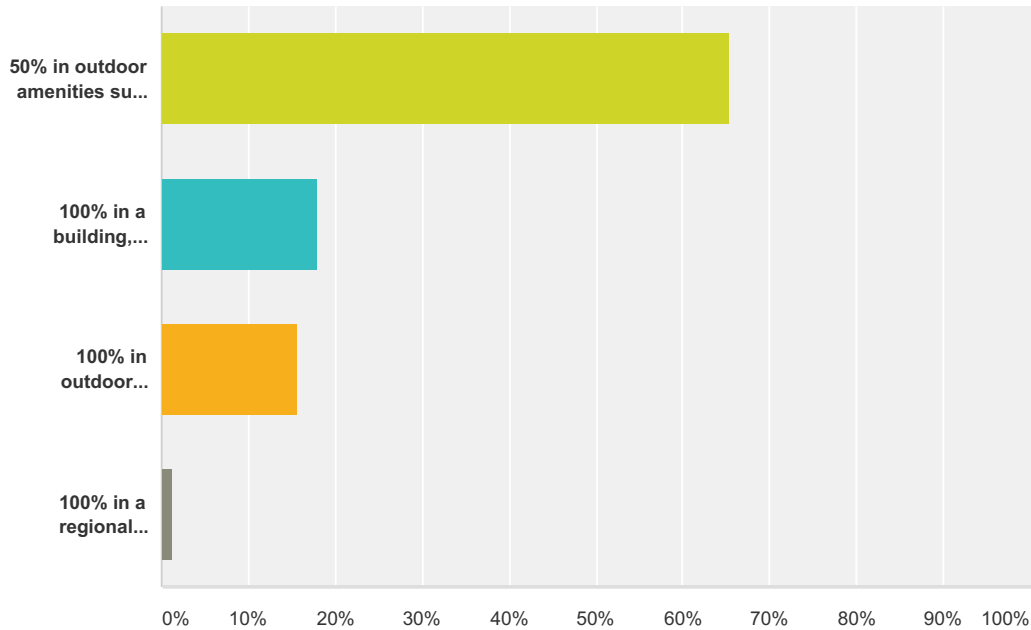
