- ✓ **Products must be in original container, with label intact**
- ✓ **Container is tightly sealed**
- ✓ **Gasoline must be returned in an approved ULC container**

How is Product Care funded?

Product Care Recycling programs are funded by environmental handling fees (EHFs), which are remitted to us by our industry members.

The fees are not a tax or a refundable deposit. The fees are used to operate the programs, including collection, transportation, and management of household hazardous waste, as well as program administration and consumer education.

EHFs are sometimes itemized on sales receipts. For specific product fees, visit productcare.org.

✓ Accepted Flammable Liquids & Gasoline

- Acetone
- BBQ lighter fluid
- Camping fuel and fondue fuel
- Flammable degreasers, lubricants, and liquid adhesives
- Flammable fuel treatment and additives
- Kerosene
- Methanol and methyl hydrate
- Mineral spirits
- Paint stripper and thinner
- Paint and varnish remover
- Turpentine and varsol
- Other flammable solvents
- Leftover, stale, or old gasoline



Flammable liquids and aerosols must display the flammable symbol



Gasoline will only be accepted in approved ULC containers. For safety reasons, containers cannot be returned after drop-off



Max. flammables size: 10 litres
Max. aerosol size: 24 ounces or 680 grams
Max. gasoline size: 25 litres

✓ Accepted Physically Hazardous Materials

This includes non-refillable **fuel cylinders** that display the flammable and explosive symbols such as camping, propane, and butane cylinders.



Max. container size: 5 kilograms

✓ Accepted Pesticides & Toxics

- Liquid and solid pesticides
- Aerosol pesticides
- Furniture stripper
- Automotive additives
- Tar and bug remover



Pesticides must display the poison symbol, the Pest Control Product (PCP) number, and the word "domestic" on the label



Toxics must display the poison symbol



Max. solid and liquid pesticide size: 10 litres
Max. aerosol size: 24 ounces or 680 grams

✓ Accepted Corrosives

- Rust remover
- Masonry and grout cleaners
- Pool and hot tub cleaners



Corrosives must have the corrosive symbol



Max. liquid/solid corrosive size: 10 litres
Max. aerosol size: 24 ounces or 680 grams



Please ensure that your products are in their original containers with an intact label, tightly sealed, and not mixed with other products. Find a full list of accepted products at [productcare.org](https://www.productcare.org)

✗ Not Accepted Products

- Unidentifiable, unknown, unlabelled and non-original containers
- Leaking or improperly sealed products
- Cleaners (e.g. *drain opener*, *bleach*)
- Oil, antifreeze, insect repellents, disinfectants, and pet products
- Commercial, industrial, or agricultural products
- Fertilizer
- Powder (*solid*) forms of masonry products, cement, grout, mortar, and plaster of Paris
- Swimming pool chemicals (e.g. *pucks*, *pH adjustors*)
- Diesel
- Refillable propane cylinders
- Caulking compound
- Cosmetics, health, and beauty aids
- Drugs, medicines, and medical sharps
- Wine and distilled spirits
- Mercury switches
- Batteries
- Ammunition
