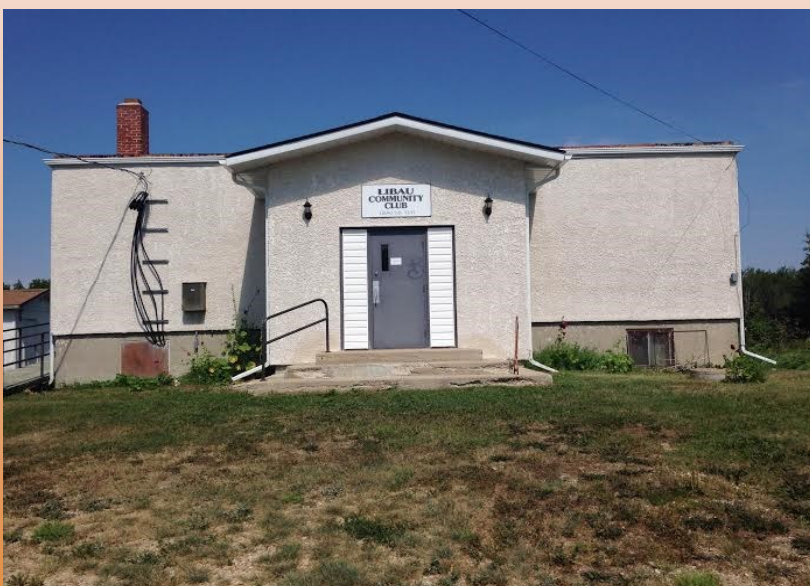

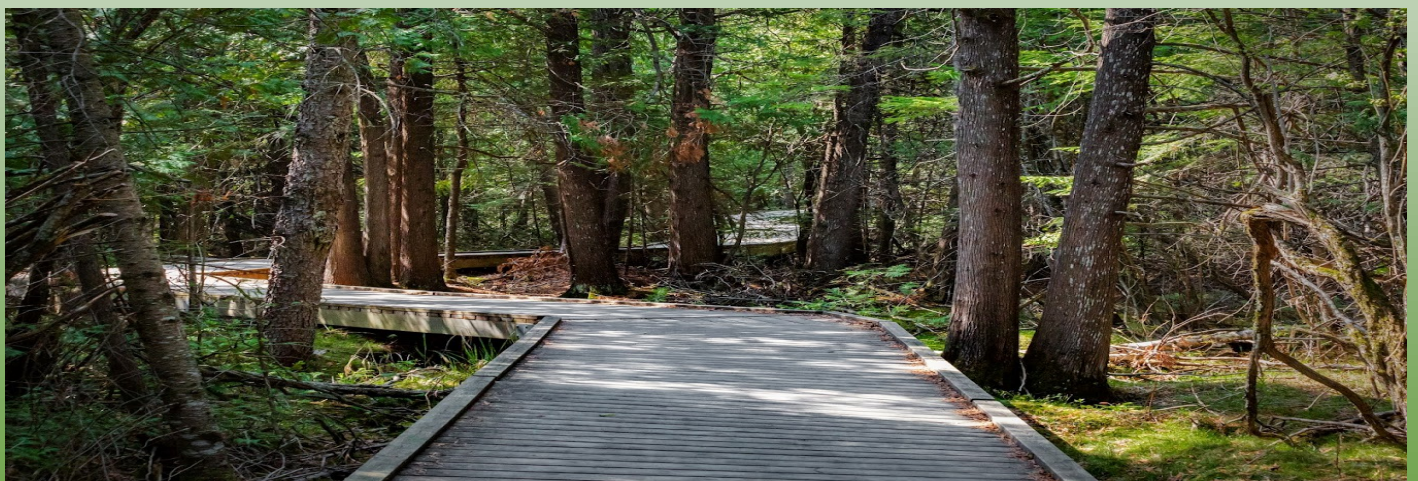


This Months Featured Location is The Brokenhead Wetland Interpretive Trail!
