GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Preparation of Proposals

Bids shall be submitted by using the enclosed BID PROPOSAL FORM that accompanies this request. Bidders should submit bids in a clear, concise and legible manner to permit proper evaluation of responsive bids.

Bidders may also submit, under separate cover with their proposal, any samples of reports and documents that are necessary to meet the requirements (deliverables) of this request should a purchase order be awarded.

2. Bid Submission

Sealed quotations marked "RFQ – 2025-11-MOTOR GRADER" will be accepted by the Rural Municipality of St Clements up to <u>December 3, 2025 at 2:00 pm</u> Central Daylight Savings Time for the supply and delivery of one or two motor graders with snow wing as per attached specifications.

Please refer to the following specifications and use the attached sheet(s) to submit your quotation. Forward quotations to: The RM of St. Clements Public Works Office located at 155 CIL Road (PR509), East Selkirk Manitoba.

3. Bid Time and Bid Forms

Bids shall be received at the RM of St. Clements Public Works Office, prior to closing.

A bidder may withdraw a proposal at any time prior to the above-scheduled date and time. Any bid received after the above-scheduled date and time shall not be considered or opened.

All bid documents contained herein must be completed in their entirety; failure to do so may disqualify a bid.

4. RM Options

The RM of St. Clements reserves the right to reject any and all bids and does not bind itself to accept the lowest bid or any proposal. The RM reserves the right to ask for new bids in whole or in part, or to reject any or all bids, or any part thereof, and to waive any requirements, irregularities, technical defects or service therein when it is deemed to be in the best interest of the RM.

If a bid does not meet or better the required specifications, requirements, and scope of work requested on all points that must be outlined in a letter attached to the bid proposal otherwise it will be presumed that the bid as proposed is in accordance with the required specifications.

If your unit does not meet or better the required specifications on all points that must be outlined in a letter; otherwise, it will be presumed that a proposal is in accordance with the required specifications.

In addition to consideration of a favorable bid, the Purchasing Department may consider the most favorable delivery date and experience.

Tenderer must make available for demonstration purposes, an identical unit as that being tendered with/without same options at no cost to the RM of St. Clements upon request.

The RM of St. Clements is interested in warranty options for the requested equipment. These should be presented as options and include the coverage, costs, and details of each option of warranty. Extended warranty is not guaranteed and is of the discretion of the RM of St. Clements based on the best option and costs.

5. Inquiries

The deadline for bidder inquiries shall be <u>1:00 pm CST on December 2, 2025</u>, after which time no additional questions will be accepted. To ensure consistent interpretation of certain items, answers to questions the RM deems to be in the interest of all bidders will be made available in writing or email as appropriate to all bidders. The RM reserves the right to communicate with any or all of the bidders to clarify the provisions of Proposals. The RM further reserves the right to request additional information from any bidder at any time after proposals are opened.

It is the sole responsibility of a bidder to verify any addendums that may have been issued relating to this request prior to submission of a proposal. Any notice of addendum shall be emailed out to bidders as well as published on the RM of St. Clements's Website https://rmofstclements.com/ Failure to submit a response that does not address any changes or addendums may result in a disqualification of proposal submission.

6. Award and Payment

A points rating system will determine whether bidders meet the required specifications and criteria. Only information provided will be considered and therefore we will not search for more information than what is stated on the attached specification sheets.

All bidders must submit a list of (2) two references of Municipalities or other agencies using their vehicles of the equivalent model and for a minimum of 5 years.

A recommendation will be made to the Council, which may or may not be based upon final point totals and price. Rural Municipality of St. Clements reserves the right to purchase equipment and machinery that it feels will provide the best value for the Rural Municipality of St. Clements.

The RM reserves the right to cancel this Proposal at any time. The Award of the Proposal, if it is to be awarded, shall be made within forty-five (45) calendar days of the date on which the Bids were opened, unless an extension of the said forty-five (45) days is mutually agreed upon in writing

between one or more Bidders and the RM. Should no award be made within the said forty-five (45) days or within any mutually agreeable extension thereof, then all Bidders shall be relieved of any obligation to enter a Contract.

The award of the Proposal will not be binding until the successful Bidder has received written notification of the award of the Proposal from the Director of Public Works of the RM of St. Clements. No other act of the RM shall constitute an award of the Proposal. The award of the Proposal shall fall under the governing laws of the Province of Manitoba.

7. Payment

Payment will be made within sixty (60) days after the delivery of the machine and all of its attachments. A holdback of up to 25% of the total value of the RFQ will be withheld until all specifications within the RFQ documents have been accepted to the satisfaction of the RM of St. Clements.

All prices shall be F.O.B. East Selkirk and include taxes (Provincial Sales Tax/Goods and Service Tax, stated separately, where applicable.) The Bidder agrees that this Tender and the prices quoted are valid and open for acceptance by the Owner for a period of forty five (45) calendar days from the date of opening of tenders. The Bidder shall indicate here any conditions which may affect the quoted price(s):

8. Instruction of Bidders

Technical Data

Complete description, specifications and drawings of proposed equipment shall accompany all quotations.

Information

Quotation forms, specifications and other information may be obtained from the Public Works Building, 155 CIL Road (PR509), East Selkirk, Manitoba.

Bidding

Bidding will consist of a (1) one sealed envelope system. The envelope will include the specifications and Price.

Evaluation

A point rating system will determine whether bidders meet the required specifications out of 100 points. Only information provided will be considered and therefore we will not search for more information than is stated on the attached specification sheets.

Acceptance/Rejection

RM of St. Clements reserves the right to reject any or all Quotations or to accept any Quotation or combination of which in the opinion of The RM of St. Clements may consider to be advantageous and best options to the RM. The lowest Quotation may not necessarily be accepted.

Warranty

Tenderer shall clearly detail any exclusion in warranty:

The RM of St. Clements is interested in extended warranty options. These should be included in the bid submission as options. Descriptions and details of these warranties must be included.

9. Intent

This specification describes a 2025 or 2026 Motor Grader with snow wing with the following minimum specifications considered necessary to perform the work assigned.

10. General Terms

All equipment must comply with the requirements of all applicable federal and provincial regulations.

RM of St. Clements reserves the right to reject any or all Quotations or to accept any Quotation or combination of which opinion the RM of St. Clements may consider to be advantageous and best options to the RM. The lowest Quotation may not necessarily be accepted.

All equipment furnished under this contract shall be new, unused, and the same as the manufacture's latest current production model. Accessories not specifically mentioned herein, but necessary to furnish a complete unit ready for safe and efficient use, shall also be included. Unit shall conform to the best practice known to the trade in design, quality of material and workmanship. Assemblies, sub-assemblies and component parts shall be standard and interchangeable throughout the entire quantity of units as specified in this invitation to quote. Equipment shall meet all applicable standards and specifications set out by the Rural Municipality of St. Clements.

All materials and workmanship shall meet the approval of the Director of Public Works or his designate. Issuance of The Rural Municipality of St. Clements purchase order and a copy of the resolution will act as the purchase agreement.

11. Application

This specification describes an articulated Motor Grader in the current Manitoba Heavy Construction Association Group 4 classification, with the following minimum specifications

considered necessary to perform the work assigned. The manufacturer shall have produced this grader for a period of at least (3) three years. Unit to be replaced is 2016 CAT 160M with Wing.

This unit must operate within temperature ranges from -50C to +40C in all types of weather conditions.

Attachments currently used with existing motor grader:

- Front CAT lift group
- Front CAT One-way plow
- 12ft Post-less Snow Wing
- Rear mounted Handy Hitch Wobblies

This unit must be new and meet all Canadian Federal, Provincial, Municipal Safety Regulations and Standards.

Any item[s] not specifically requested but known to the vendor as being necessary for the safe, efficient use of the equipment proposed shall be clearly noted on the Bid Form. Otherwise it will be assumed these item[s] will be supplied at the proposed price.

Please submit a full brochure and specification sheet on the unit being sold.

Appendix 1 indicates the minimum specifications and must be filled in and submitted with the Bid Form.

The proposed unit must be specified to operate all optional attachments set out in the bid form.

12. Schedule

The RM of St. Clements intends to evaluate the Proposals and provide recommendations within Three (3) weeks of Proposal closing.

13. Selection Process/Criteria

The Proposals will first be reviewed for completeness and inclusion of the components specified in the Proposal documents. Proposals will be excluded from further analyses which are clearly non-responsive to the stated requirements.

The RM reserves the right to contact or interview any or all Bidders to clarify their submission.

The RM has established the following evaluation criteria for this procurement. These criteria will allow the RM to analyze Proposals received on an equal basis and provide the Proposers with the basis on which the RM will evaluate all Proposals.

14. Trade in of Existing Unit (s)

The RM of St. Clements is looking for trade a trade in value on both graders. The 2017 CAT 160M may be traded in if the RM decides there is good value to buy two graders at once. At that point the RM will decide if one or two graders may be traded in. The 2016 CAT 160M may be traded in if the RM receives good value.

- MG01 2016 CAT 160M with Snow Wing
- Optional MG03 2017 CAT 160M with Snow Wing

15. Evaluation Scheme

Total evaluation will be out of 100 points

Evaluation Phase I

- Adherence to Specifications as per Appendix 1. (15 points)
- New proposed unit resale value at 15 years old **(10 points)** Must supply a minimum of 3 examples of recent similar units at third party auctions
- Lowest cost of ownership maintenance, fuel consumption, etc (10 points)
- Delivery Time (5 points)
- Total cost of proposed unit (10 points)
- Trade in value of 2016 or 2017 CAT 160M with Snow Wing (5 points)
- Performance/past experience with the RM of St. Clements (15 points) If bidder(s) have no previous experience with the RM then references may be used in determining performance.

Evaluation Phase II

- Product Demonstration (30 points)
 - Ability of the equipment to perform in the municipal environment, including but not limited to ergonomics, productivity, safety, ease of use, ease of maintenance, and capability for the RM. This will be measured based upon the Bidder's detailed specifications as per Appendix 1 and the product presentation and demonstration for shortlisted Bidders.

Shortlisted Bidders will be required to provide the RM of St. Clements with the demonstration of a unit that has similar capabilities to the proposed unit for an in the field demonstration. This demonstration will take place on site in the RM of St. Clements. All costs associated with the demonstration are the responsibility of the Bidder. Any deviations between the proposed unit and the demonstrator unit must be provided to the RM of St. Clements, in writing, in advance of the demonstration.

The demonstration is to be provided in a timely fashion. If a Bidder cannot arrange the demonstration within a reasonable time, as determined by the RM, the RM reserves the right to proceed with the evaluation process and rate the Bidder based on the information provided in their proposal and forego the demonstration. The RM employees will operate the demonstration unit and score in their opinion based on multiple factors including but not limited to power, functionality, comfort, safety, controls, etc. This will also factor in the 30-point rating.
