Your Council's request to withdraw from the Manitoba Capital Planning Region (CPR) Board of Directors has been given effect by regulation as of May 12, 2026 through an amendment to the Capital Planning Region – Regional Member Municipalities Regulation, M.R. 84/2025.

The Capital Planning Region - Regional Member Municipalities Regulation, amendment M.R. 40/2026 is now law and can be found on the Manitoba e-laws website:

The Government of Manitoba remains committed to advancing regional planning in the Capital Planning Region.
