

Rural Municipality of St. Clements Celebrates Grand Opening of New Activity Centre made possible through funding from the Government of Canada and the Province of Manitoba.

The Rural Municipality of St. Clements, the Government of Canada and Province of Manitoba is pleased to celebrate the official grand opening of the new St. Clements Activity Centre, a major community investment that represents years of planning, collaboration, and commitment to recreation opportunities for residents.

With a total project investment of \$8.70 million, the Activity Centre marks the completion of a long-standing vision to create a modern, accessible space where residents of all ages can gather, participate in recreation, and build connections within the community.

In 2020, the project received \$2.7 million through the Province of Manitoba's Climate Resiliency Grant Program, supporting important site improvements and infrastructure.

In 2022, the Government of Canada, Province of Manitoba, and the RM of St. Clements announced joint funding of \$6,136,946 through the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP) toward construction of the new Activity Centre.

These investments helped make it possible for the RM to create a facility that will support recreation, wellness, and community connection for generations to come.
